6 week duration each

Individuals, groups, collectives and curators in all visual arts media may apply; professional fees paid and accommodations provided (3 night minimum); travel and per diems dependent on funding.

All documents should be sent in a .zip folder via email (subject "submission") or on one cd. Documents should be in .pdf or .doc format - **no paper** and no power point documents please.

For individual artists and collectives:

- 2 page CV
- 100 word bio
- 1 page artist statement
- 1 page project proposal (including technical requirements)
- detailed numbered Image list
- 10 images (jpeg. 768 x 1024 px) applicable to your proposal and / or quick time video (max 5 minutes) and/or wav files for audio

For curators:

- 2 page CV
- 100 word bio
- 1 page curatorial proposal
- 1 example of published critical writing
- Visual support material welcome if applicable at this stage, following same guidelines as individual artists.

ART MARATHON FESTIVAL
DEADLINE MAR 31
mid-August every year

Highly participatory, the Art Marathon complements Eastern Edge's yearly programming by offering artistic diversity with a focus on community outreach and audience participation.

Individuals, groups, collectives and curators in all visual arts media may apply; professional fees paid, travel paid, and accommodations provided (3 night minimum); per diems dependent on funding.

Artists are encouraged to propose a variety of contemporary art actions, both large and small, which could include:

- performances (site-specific or staged)
- local community collaboration (interactive works)
- video/sound/off-site installation
- related workshops (for all ages or specific)

Please note: artists applying to participate in the closing Art Marathon event (24 hours of live art making onsite) apply in a separate form at a later date.

Please follow the guidelines for Main Gallery submissions.

PIN-IN GALLERY
SUBMIT ANYTIME
small button art
up to 6 shows a year
2 month duration

Individuals, groups, collectives and curators in all visual arts media may apply; \$50 fee paid; 100 buttons made in house, 10 go to artist.

- images of proposed button design
- CV
- short bio
- project/button image statement
